The Royal Commission into Aged Care will investigate the deficiencies in the aged care system and will assist to shift the pace of change and reform.

The Terms of Reference will allow investigation across a range of issues including:

- Management systems, staffing and organisational development
- Hygiene, quality of food and sanitary conditions
- Instances of abuse, reportable assaults and neglect
- Restrictions on freedom and movement including restraints
- Failure of care and theft of belongings
