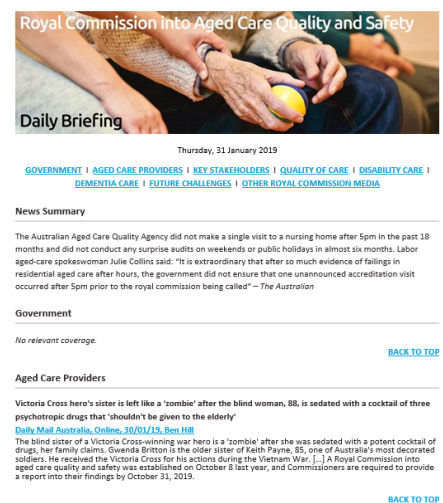


What is the **Royal Commission** into Aged Care Quality and Safety?

The Terms of Reference will allow investigation across a range of issues including:

- Instances of abuse, reportable assaults and neglect
- Restrictions on freedom and movement including restraints
- Failure of care and theft of belongings
